Covenant for Weekend of the CROSS

As a participant, I agree to covenant with everyone else to abide by the following regulations:

1. Everyone, youth and adult, is expected to abide by the schedule and attend all group meetings, work times, and worship experiences. Only by fully participating in all activities can each person get the maximum benefits.
2. As guests of Centenary College, area churches, and work sites, we expect everyone to respect all buildings, equipment, and property by refraining from intentionally causing harm or removing any furniture from any room.
3. In order to better serve others by working on the sites and be better witnesses for Christ, we expect everyone to honor the lights out and quiet times designated by the leaders.
4. Since there are separate sleeping areas for boys and girls, the areas of the opposite sex are off-limits at all times. Weekend of the Cross Staff reserves the right to enter any room for any reason.
5. The possession or use of drugs, tobacco, alcohol, fireworks, or firearms is not permitted and will not be tolerated. The use or possession of any of these items will result in an early trip home. Since our accommodations are on school property, the use or possession of some of these items are illegal, and may result in an arrest as well.
6. The use of any prescription drugs must be known by the director of the Weekend, as well as the adult group leader before the Weekend or no later than registration.
7. Transportation will be provided to all activities by designated adults once participants are registered at Centenary on Thursday evening. No youth will be allowed to drive any vehicle during the Weekend.
8. All meals will be provided by Weekend of the Cross. Therefore participants will not be allowed to leave assigned areas to obtain meals/snacks/drinks, and will not be allowed to have food delivered.
9. No outside youth will be allowed at Weekend of the Cross.
10. Long Pants, Shirts with Sleeves, and Work Boots / Reg. Shoes (covering your toes) are to be worn on the work sites. No shorts, sleeveless shirts, or open toe-shoes (flip-flops or sandals) on the sites. All Shirts must cover your mid-riff.
11. Above all, remember to respect each person we come in contact with during the Weekend. We are witnesses of ourselves, our home churches, and the Weekend of the CROSS to the community. Let's make sure that it's a good witness that will be pleasing to Christ.
